### Actions from last site visit: First three points remain as per last visit.

- Site notice boards insitu. As noted above provision of these advertisements need confirming with the District Council. Update: Advertisements need confirming with the District Council.
- Ecological Management Delivery Plan needs submission. Update Supporting assessments prepared.
- Condition 9 Annual survey of waste importation. Update: Outstanding.
  Planning condition requirement separate from any Waste Local
  Plan survey requirements.
- Clearance from infringement of eastern stockpile hedgerow. Update: Outstanding.
- Movement back behind screen bunding of screener/crusher plant.
  Update: Screener whilst positioning is close to edge of recycling area there should be no further movement eastwards.
- Regularising the "Zapp" shelter. **Update: Scheme discharged.**
- Regularising the satellite/antenna mast atop the batching plant. Update: Outstanding.

# Inspection Results Summary:

- Site entrance and carriageway clean although verge continues with its deterioration outside site.
- Site notice boards insitu. As noted previously these advertisements need confirming with the District Council.
- Storage bays in recycling area nearest site entrance filled with stone and some sand.
- Recycling plant operating at time of visit. Large stockpiles under all conveyor arms of sands and gravels. Again noted that majority of the stocks and feed source appears to be virgin mineral/hoggin and stone.
- Yard operating area clean. Concrete batching plant operational.
- ADT delivering mineral to main hopper stockpile.
- Eastern area of recycling yard has numerous stockpiles of recyclate along with parked up crusher/screening units. Crusher in same location as at last monitoring visit and appears to have further breakdown issues.
- Restored area in south eastern corner (horse paddock) dry and not walked on this occasion. No horses in fields.
- Lake area east of haul road filled with water although slightly lower than last visit. Number of swan/duck and young present. All three islands visible.

- Large expanse of restored land around the utility lines now ready for grading out of silt deposit and grass seeding. This work likely to be undertaken in near future.
- Western lagoon complex filled with water. PS confirmed programme of ongoing lagoon clearance being undertaken. One lagoon nearest recycling area being actively pumped out and will have silt removal towards end of the week.
- Inerts being delivered to northern tipping area.
- Mineral being removed from northern edge of site (Phase 7). Estimated some 6 week mineral remaining in final dig. PS advised geo barrier starting 19<sup>th</sup> of month to create further cell in north eastern corner. Likely 18 months for completion of infilling in remaining void.
- Final extraction to be as haul road removed.
- As previously reported in last monitoring report, the erection of satellite dish mast atop the concrete batching plant would also need regularising.
