Actions from last site visit: Remain as per the last 2 monitoring visit as well as the update comments.

- Height of site stockpiles to be maintained to their designated heights. Update: Kept on record as reminder.
- Stockpiling area only to be used for stocking purposes. Update: Still outstanding. Use
 of the land for screening purposes requires either to be regularised or for the
 machinery/plant to be removed.
- Tidying up of the plant/machinery parts located within the stockpiling area; concrete
 batching plant and north western corner on perimeter of site where lake float raft
 elements are stored now outside the fencing line whilst various other pieces of metal
 and blue plastic barrels now becoming engulfed as sand from the stockpile area is
 blown by the wind over the redundant items. Three large drainage pipes upended
 and located in sand stocking area. Update: Accumulations of redundant
 plant/machinery and odd items still stored in various points around site.
- Demarcating boundary of aftercare/active as per the Plan B7m/178. **Update: Fence** posts in and fencing carried out.
- Measures to address tree planting along northern site boundary. Update: Appears
 most of the remaining trees transplanted either dormant or dead. Ground vegetation
 growth cleared as if someone has been in fenced off area and cut any growth to
 ground level. Update: Replanting to be looked at.

Inspection Results Summary:

- Site bellmouth clean at time of visit.
- Three front loaders parked up alongside the refuelling tanks.
- Stored portacabin remains in car park and earmarked for replacing existing toilet block. Despite reported at last monitoring visit that following conversation with site foreman this replacement was to be instigated shortly after that previous visit.
- in next week or so. Existing portacabins still in use. Redundant portacabin still to be removed off site. Office location beginning to look untidy with redundant portacabin and ISO container storage.
- Area around back of offices over grown so not possible to ascertain whether the
 previously recorded discarded metal items/pipework and other miscellaneous
 objects still insitu. Likewise not possible to view fully the banking where there had
 been recorded general litter comprising plastic bucket/plastic bagging/metal objects
 and smaller waste that appeared to have been deliberately tipped down the
 banking.
- Ground from the back of the offices westwards to silt lagoon despite having the red and white chain fencing in places the path, as was the rest of the site bunds and hedgerow planting areas heavily weed infested and trip hazards. Weeds growing on

- safety path alongside site haul road opposite site offices meant you had to walk either on the road or up the banking.
- AJ expressed view that he would like to see the roadside hedge managed and layed. Previous cut branches remain stacked behind on site side and along hedgerow line. AJ expressed view that the stacking and an inner fence line made management of the hedge from the site side difficult although road side trimming could be undertaken.
- As previously recorded the lagoon nearest highway remains. Considerable amount
 of exposed silt which AJ and BA again confirmed plans for recycling the silt. As with
 other aspects of the site where soil use/overburden requirements and tipping void
 space as result of silt lagoon clearance was being assessed in light of the future
 southern extension programme. AJ noted that overburden from the southern
 extension was being looked at for use in the restoration of the western quarry
 phases.
- Wildflower meadow in bloom across the previously restored land between the silt lagoon and conveyor line. Gorse continuing to spread on soil bund slopes.
 Perimeter hedgeline to Palmers Cottages growing out into site and in need of tree guard removal.
- Perimeter tree belt planting on western perimeter due for thinning. Tree guards also to be addressed.
- Last remaining mineral, forming an island, being worked from the void with the long reach excavator sitting on top. Base of void uneven with islands of overburden surrounded by water and establishing vegetation.
- Final Phase of mineral between void and retained hedgerow covered with thistle as are the bunds to the north which prevented viewing of the transplant planting on the perimeter.
- Stockpiling area fairly empty other than for the continued build up of miscellaneous discarded items and skips within the corner of the storage area where the proposed bagging facility is to be situated. Additional items including old drag line bucket and a portacabin located on the north western permitter of the storage area.
- Along the north eastern edge of the stockpiling area a bund has been created from the pulling back of material that previously lay around the base of the tree line and existing track that forms the northern boundary.
- Just in from the bunding silt/overburden material has been tipped and graded out. Not sure whether this material is awaiting further reprocessing.
- Old silt lagoon that had been topsoiled a few years ago showing signs of settlement across most of the central surface. AJ confirmed this land to be, along with the more northern silt lagoon now with established vegetation and mostly willow trees have been earmarked for return to the landowner. Following walk through of the northern former silt lagoon, this land has settled a metre or two plus from the restored land further north. AJ and BA to discuss options for return/marrying in of the lagoon with the more northern land.
- Extent of the sand stockpiling area in this extreme north eastern corner of the site
 questioned. Potential for pulling this boundary into the site proper could be option.
 Powerscreen still in location just to south of the north eastern sand stokpiling area.
- Processing plant being serviced by two cranes. Barrel washer being replaced. BA noted that opportunity of having the cranes on site could see some movement of the redundant plant/machinery around the site.
- Concrete plant did not appear operational at time of the visit.
