Actions from last site visit: Remain as per the last 3 monitoring visit as well as the update comments.

- Height of site stockpiles to be maintained to their designated heights. Update: Kept on record as reminder.
- Stockpiling area only to be used for stocking purposes. Update: Still outstanding. Use of the land for screening purposes requires either to be regularised or for the machinery/plant to be removed.
- Tidying up of the plant/machinery parts located within the stockpiling area; concrete batching plant and north western corner on perimeter of site where lake float raft elements are stored now outside the fencing line whilst various other pieces of metal and blue plastic barrels now becoming engulfed as sand from the stockpile area is blown by the wind over the redundant items. Three large drainage pipes upended and located in sand stocking area. Update: Accumulations of redundant plant/machinery and odd items still stored in various points around site.
- Measures to address tree planting along northern site boundary. Update: Appears most of the remaining trees transplanted either dormant or dead. Ground vegetation growth cleared as if someone has been in fenced off area and cut any growth to ground level. Update: Replanting to be looked at.

Inspection Results Summary:

- Site bellmouth clean at time of visit.
- Site office/welfare block operational. Redundant portacabin unit has been removed.
- As noted at previous monitoring visit report "Ground from the back of the offices westwards to silt lagoon despite having the red and white chain fencing in places the path, as was the rest of the site bunds and hedgerow planting areas heavily weed infested and trip hazards. Weeds growing on safety path alongside site haul road opposite site offices meant you had to walk either on the road or up the banking."
- Processing area busy at start of visit with a number of Tipper/Artics visiting and receiving sand.
- Western lagoon has started to have some silt removed from north eastern corner. Recovery potential of the silt for marketability was being assessed.
- Restored land between lagoon and conveyor walked over and good ground cover established. AH considering topping later next year.
- Gorse growth continues to spread on soil bund slopes along road side and Palmers Cottage.
- As per last monitoring visit report and with no apparent action then the following points remain valid "Perimeter hedgeline to Palmers Cottages growing out into site and in need of tree guard removal.

- Perimeter tree belt planting on western perimeter due for thinning. Tree guards also to be addressed."
- Western void area now worked out with clay base showing and water level down. Long reach excavator taking out final mineral from base. Dump truck and front loader feeding conveyor hopper.
- Last remaining mineral, forming an island, being worked from the void with the long reach excavator sitting on top. Base of void uneven with islands of overburden surrounded by water and establishing vegetation.
- Final unworked Phase 7 and 8 remains covered with thistle as are the bunds to the north.
- Transplant planting on northern perimeter not visited during this visit.
- Working continuing in Phase 6b with front loader transporting mineral to far hopper on western end of conveyor run.
- Stock piling area accommodating varying stocks of sand and stone approximately 5

 8 metres at highest elevation.
- Stockpiling of redundant items of miscellaneous nature continues to grow in the south western corner. 3 red Biffa liveried skips placed nearby. One large black coloured RO-RO skip to the north. Alongside the redundant items delivery has taken place of the bagging plant infrastructure which is scheduled for construction in this location.
- Former silt lagoon on eastern side of site that has had settlement, AH confirmed that soils to be stripped and depression to be infilled.
- Eastern side of the site the remnants of the floating platform/pipework/concrete pipe parts and other discarded items remain lying around.
- Eastern stockpiling area now accommodating a further sand stockpile approximately 3-4m metres high.
- One or two HGVs (one artic and one tipper) leaving site appearing to be speeding and creating dust. Photographs taken.
