## Actions from last site visit:

 Keeping the site entrance clear of mud/debris and confirmation as to procedures to maintain this position. Update: Kept on for monitoring by operator At time of visit the site entrance and crossover were clear.

- Completion of the cut off ditches and diversion/collection of surface water runoff from wet recycling area to prevent discharge into eastern copse and processing of the water. Update: Ditches to be finalised. Lego blocks demarcate the eastern site boundary.
- Eastern site boundary of the wet recycling area needs to be in accordance with the approved site plan and the approved screening measures instigated. The extent of the recycled material stockpiles outside of their permitted areas needs to be regularised through their removal and reduction in footprint. **Update: ego blocks have been placed on perimeter as noted previously.**
- Planting up of the roadside bund this planting season. Update: JB indicated utility operator are now expected on site in near future and removal of sand stockpiles undertaken to allow utility company access.
- Removal of the general storage from car parking area adjacent industrial estate entrance on north side of road. Update: Carparking area cleaned and clear of items.
- Potential for erected visual height marker in stockpiling area alongside wet recycling plant. Update: Still not actioned. Action Point JB
- Clearance of remaining silt from haul road ditch. **Update: Ditch has been cleaned** although it appears wider as excavation works to clean ditch taken place.
- CLEUD parcel regularising issues. Update: Still awaited. GM considering to get application in soonest to address regularisation aspects and then to look at future proposals for the asbestos handling.

## **Inspection Results**

- Site entrance clear although road verges southwards along highway evidence of cutting in with tyre tracks.
- Site quiet, JB advised plant down for maintenance week. Stockpile of sand near site
  entrance has been reduced in quantity and moved away from site boundary to allow
  utility company access for future line realignment.

- A number of articulated lorries parked up behind site offices delivering products to site
- Block making area active although JB noted that wet weather causing breakages and blocks sticking to ground.
- Concrete batching plant operational
- Stockpiles of blocks about 3 -4 metres high placed at the yards eastern end and alongside the bagging shed. Bays placed on western side of bagging/maintenance area being used to store similar product as being handled in the dry recycling area.
- Lego block moulds not being used at time of visit.
- Mobile "Kleemann" crusher parked up on southern side of bagging/maintenance area as well as mobile conveyor unit.
- Former silt lagoon on north western boundary has had breach with works ongoing as weather permits to remove silt and backfill being undertaken to enable expansion of the operational yard up to the tree line.
- Wet recycling stockpile had one HGV delivering material in stockpile although wet recycling plant quiet and in maintenance with large stockpile of silt pressing stored within northern central portion of the yard. This material was being dried out and would be used in restoration as ground conditions improved.
- Yard fronting boundary has been cleaned up.
- South of the road the dry recycling area active with front loader servicing stocks.
   Stockpiles now reduced in quantity and footprint.
- Picking belt unit remains on site.
- A mobile Powersrceen sitting on a slightly raised platform about 2 metres high with a feeder arm out over another screener unit were positioned in the central northern half of the yard and operational.
- JB awaiting some financial surplus to invest in acquiring further Lego blocks for demarcating northern boundary. Alternatives being to utilise existing blocks now being used to demarcate the product stores existing within the central portion of the recycling yard footprint.
- Haul road to voids holding up well. Ditch on west cleaned out and filled with water.
   Haul road has large amounts of slurry on surface but this is restricted to the road and not escaping to the watercourse.
- Void has developed with the eastern cell virtuallyup to restoration level. JB advised that the northern half of the void now having 3 sub cells. Cell 1b in centre being constructed with cell 1c being infilled in the non hazardous infilling to accommodate the future haul road for the western extension.
- The soil store in central southern portion being removed and found mostly to be of silt composition. This is being used to bring the inert cell up to restoration level.
- Clay liner still to be continued around southern and south eastern walls to link into barrier around cell in the north east near gas flare.
